TROPICAL STORM IDA**

ORDER


Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1; pursuant to LA R.S. 1:55, and the inherent power of this Court, and Governor John Bel Edwards' declaration of an emergency in Executive Department Proclamation 165 JBE 2021, and considering the potential dangerous condition associated with the tropical weather system Ida:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, First City Court, and Second City Court will close at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, August 27, 2021, and will remain closed through Monday, August 30, 2021. The Court will resume normal operations on Tuesday, August 31, 2021 at 8:30 a.m. contingent upon weather conditions and infrastructure impact from the tropical weather system.
