Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1; pursuant to LA R.S. 1:55, and the inherent power of this Court, and given that the Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness is closing state offices in Orleans Parish at noon, and in consideration of the anticipated hazardous weather conditions, the threat of high winds and flooding, and other safety risks for the public and court staff: the Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, First City Court, and Second City Court, and the buildings at 421 Loyola Ave. and 225 Morgan St. in New Orleans will close at noon Wednesday, March 30, 2022. The Courts and buildings will reopen and resume normal operations on Thursday, March 31, 2022.
