MARCH 10, 2023**

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1; pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55, and the inherent power of this Court, and in consideration of the fact that there was a fire in the Court building on Sunday, February 12, 2023, and that all necessary environmental and safety procedures are now completed, Judge Monique E. Barial, acting on behalf of the Judges En Banc,

Hereby Orders That:

The building at 421 Loyola Ave. which houses the Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, First City Court, the District Court Clerk of Court, the First City Court Clerk of Court, offices of the Civil Division of the Orleans Parish Sheriff, and the First City Court Constable, will reopen to the public on Monday, March 13, 2023 at 8:00am for normal operations.

Thursday, March 23


